

Felt Ranunculus Flowers Supply List and Pattern



Dreamy Ranunculus from Handmade Felt

Our flowers are both wet felted and needle felted to really bring them to life!

Supplies:

- [Merino Top](#) or other fine fiber (we are using 19micron Merino Top)
*select 1 or more colors that you like together for the petals, and green for wet felting leaves if desired. For a quick selection, see our varieties of [STUDIO PACKS](#)
- Select a Merino Top color for the stamens
If desired, select a color for the leaves or use MC-1 Batting
- For the Stem and Pistil, we chose [MC-1 BATTING](#) and you can also use Merino Top
- Luster fibers as desired -- we are using these for sheen

- [Olive oil soap](#) or other hard milled vegetable soap. (think slick and low suds)
- [Wet felting mesh](#)
- [Thin plastic sheeting](#)
- Wooden Dowel 1" - 2" in diameter
- Towels
- Water
- [Palm washboard](#) (optional)
- [Ball brause](#) (optional) or Kitchen Sponge
- [Needle Felting Foam](#)
- [Felting Needles](#) 38Star and 42Triangle (single and cluster of 3 rubber banded)
- Fabric Scissors


Also, you may want a simple gift to give as a way of saying "thanks", or "I love you", "I am thinking of you" Happy Birthday or even "Happy Mother's Day".






Cut 6-12

*if there is a "grain" to your felt fabric, cut the petals so the grain runs as shown.



Cut 10-12+



Cut 12+

Ranunculus asiaticus are a lovely flower with many layers. This project aims to capture the essence of this species of buttercup admired for its many lacy layers of petals.

It is possible to have a somewhat thicker felt and still create a beautiful flower, but experiment with the thickness of your felt and add as many rows of petals as you desire to create the flower you envision.
