## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS**

Handmade felt
100% Wool Felt
MC-1 Wool Batting

Yarns

Embroidery floss Beads, notions

Felting Needles: 42T, 40T Needle felting foam

Iron

Freezer Paper

Heat-n-Bond Iron-on Adhesive

**Pressing cloth** 

**Rotary Cutter** 

**Cutting Mat** 

Freezer Paper

Pen: Regular, Disappearing, Pencil

Stencils Cardstock

Pins

Double sided tape

Needles: Sewing, Embroidery

Scissors: Embroidery, paper, fabric

## **MEASURE & CUT**

Freezer Paper 9 x 11.5 Fabric white 9.5 x 12 Colored Paper 8.5 x 11



Shown here is one of our handmade felt fabrics. For the flower project, you might consider more consistency and less "sporadic" designs than shown here.

Once your fabric is dry, steam press it if desired before creating your felt appliqué.


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These are the same size circles used on our project.
